- Susan Cooper to finish with W2s before ending term with Uptown BID
- Will hand over keys to the office at Conservation Corps
- Need physical address for PO Box
- Will submit reimbursement for Board website, \$588 for 1-year
- Recommend update Board Bylaws Best Practices every 5-years; Uptown BID going into 6th year, and review compliance guidelines
